

What Fruit are You Eating?

Moshe's teachings help to direct a person toward Oneness and the return to the Garden of Eden and the Tree of Life, while demystifying lofty and often hard-to-understand concepts, correcting errors of ancient gender biases, and bringing reality down to a very simple level where even children can understand, and often understand best. Much of Moshe Daniel's teachings center around the story of Adam and Eve, to help set the record straight about Eve, the female's role about creation, to find the balance between the male and the female energies, to bring to light a subject which is of utmost importance for our evolution as individuals and as a race of human beings.
